## MUST SEE PLACES

### MANGALURU

It is officially known as Mangaluru and is the chief port city of the Indian state of Karnataka. It is located about 352 kilometres west of the state



capital, Bengaluru between the Arabian Sea and the Western Ghat mountain ranges. The city has tropical climate. Mangalore's port handles 75 percent of India's coffee and cashew exports. It is a commercial, industrial, educational and healthcare hub on the west coast. The city's landscape is characterized by rolling hills, coconut palms, freshwater streams and hard red-clay tiled roof buildings. Popular places include Kadri Manjunath Temple known for its bronze statues, Milagres Church and St. Aloysius Chapel which features interior paintings. Tannirbhavi beach is popular for its sunset views.

### GOA (350 kms from Mangaluru)



Goa is a state in Western India with coastlines stretching along the Arabian Sea. Well-known for its beaches, places of worship and world heritage architecture, it has become people's choice for tourism. It is India's smallest state and Panaji is its capital. Ranked best placed state by the eleventh Finance Commission for its infrastructure and ranked on top for the best quality of life in India by the National Commission on Population. Margoa still exhibits the cultural influence of the Portuguese. It has rich flora and fauna as it is located on Western Ghats range, a biodiversity spot.

### KERALA (adjacent district 40 kms from Mangaluru to Malbar Kerala)

Known as God's own country is a state on India's tropical Malabar Coast consisting of 600 km of Arabian Sea shoreline. The name Kerala derives from "Kera" which means Coconut tree in Malyalam and "alam" is land, thus land of coconuts. It is nicknamed due to abundance of coconut trees and its used by the locals. It is famous for its palm-lined beaches and backwaters, a network of canals. National parks like Eravikulam and Periyar, plus Wayanad and other sanctuaries, are home to Elephants, langur



Monkeys and Tigers. Inland are the western ghats whose slopes sustains tea, coffee and spice plantations besides wild life.

### KODAGU (125 kms from Mangaluru)



It is an administrative district in Karnataka, India. It occupies an area of 4,102 square kilometers in the Western Ghats of southwestern Karnataka. The district is bordered by Dakshina Kannada district to the northwest, Kasargod district of Kerala to the west, Hassan district to the north, Mysore district to the East, Kannur district of Kerala to the southwest, and the Wayanad district of Kerala to the South. Agriculture is the most important factor that upholds the economy of Kodagu and the main crops cultivated in this region are rice and Coffee. Coorg is rich in natural resources which includes timber and spices.

### MALENADU (120 kms from Mangaluru)



It is a region in the state of Karnataka in India. It covers the western and eastern slopes of the Western ghats or Sahyadri mountain Range and is approximately 100 kilometers in width. It is situated between Coastal Karnataka and Bayaluseeme regions of Karnataka. The word Malenadu is derived from 'male' which means rain and 'nadu' meaning 'land', hence 'Land of rain'. The hills of Malenadu are richly forested. Coffee and Arecanut are grown in this region.
